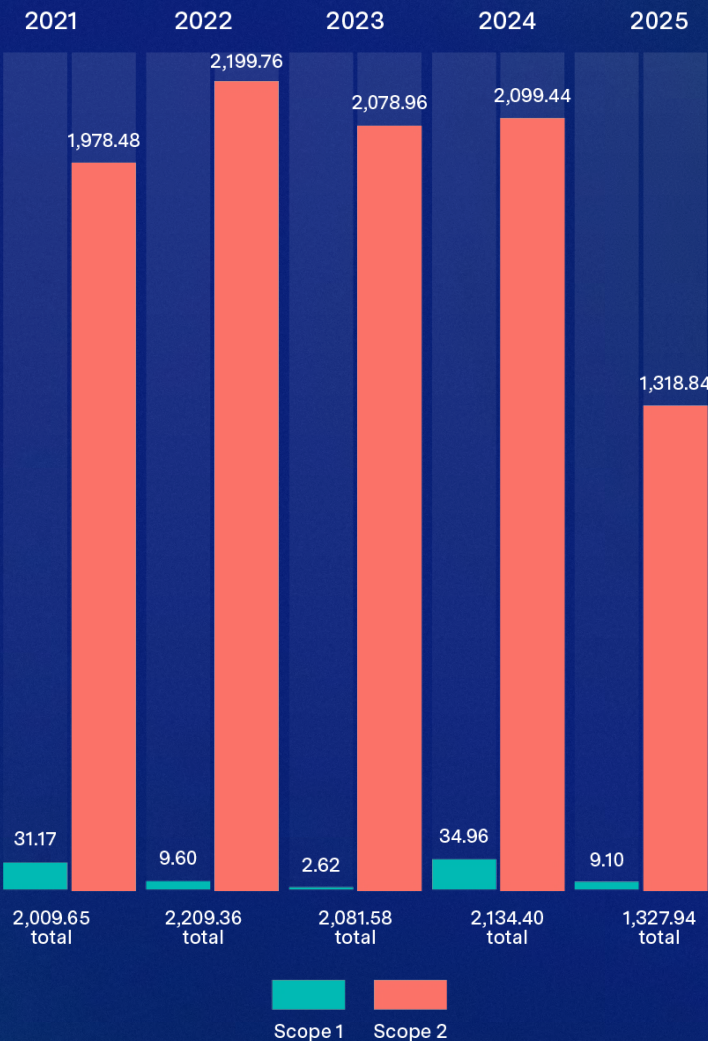
We disclose our greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and assess climate-related risks and opportunities in accordance with the Task Force on Climate-related Financial Disclosures (TCFD) framework. Our GHG inventory is prepared in alignment with the Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (GHG Protocol), as part of our effort to provide clear and accurate reporting aligned with best practices. We delineate our organizational boundary for GHG emissions using the operational control approach—meaning we include activities where Radian has authority to implement operating policies.

Although Radian’s overall carbon footprint remains modest, we are tracking changes and making efforts to understand its impact. Variations between reporting periods may reflect changes in office occupancy levels, energy consumption at corporate facilities, operational footprint adjustments, or changes in energy sources used at Radian locations.

Our ongoing commitment to transparency and climate responsibility is part of our broader mission of creating long-term value for our employees, communities, and other stakeholders. Through these efforts, we strive to help build a more sustainable future for all.
